



HALLOWEEN COSTUME GUIDELINES

Dear Parents and Students,

On Thursday, October 29, 2015, students will be allowed to dress for Halloween. Students are allowed to wear costumes, but must be in compliance with current dress code rules, e.g. clothing shall cover the midriff, underwear, back and cleavage at all times. Skirts, shorts, dresses etc., must be at mid-thigh when the student is seated. Leggings are allowed only if the top worn is long enough to cover the student modestly. Tank tops, low cut tops and spaghetti straps will not be permitted. Straps must be at least 3 inches in width. Masks and full-face paint will not be allowed, as we need to be able to determine who the student is. Weapons and facsimiles of weapons are not permitted. Also, costumes must be free of any reference to drugs or alcohol.

Students will be allowed to have temporary hair color; however, the hair dye will need to be completely removed by the time students return to school on Monday, November 2nd.

Students who are not in compliance with the established dress code will be asked to change. If they are unable to change, they will be asked to return home to change or go home. If you have any questions, please contact the FHMS administration at (801)412-2450.
